## What is a Member's Communication Role in Social Butterflies?

As a member of Social Butterflies the member has a "communication" responsibility. This means that the member should communicate with Queen Mum Debb if any issue, interest or ER occurs in the member's life that might prevent them from partaking in any Social Butterflies activity.

It could be a health issue or any other issue in the member's life that would hinder them from attending. The member can make this issue a private one between Queen Mum Debb and the member only; or advise Queen Mum Debb she can share it with the chapter.

Communication may consist of a text, email, snail mail, or phone call to just apprise Queen Mum Debb why the member cannot take part in any Social Butterflies events or activities for any period of time.

We understand that factors like life changes, health issues, and interest, may change or keep members from participating. Just as with any other group/chapter communication is always a must and encouraged to keep your membership active and to prevent any misunderstandings.
